- Everyone skates together from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m.
- 11:00 a.m. Ms. Backmeyers class back on the bus at the arena to return to GES
- 11:30 a.m. Mrs. Eaton and Mr. Moslin classes back on bus at the arena to return to GES
- Students wanting to skate must be prepared with skates and a helmet (acceptable helmets include: bike, hockey, motorcycle, ski, equestrian). Midway arena has limited extras so please do your best to round up gear for your child.
- Students **must** wear gloves/mitts and are encouraged to wear snow pants.
- Regular hockey sticks are not allowed—floor hockey sticks will be available.
- Your child will be supervised by his/her classroom teacher and other GES staff members.
- There are no alternate activities planned for this day as the entire school will be participating in this adventure
